RE: RESOLUTION NO. 98-6 - A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RESOLUTION OF FORMATION FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 TO MODIFY THE MANNER OF COLLECTION OF THE SPECIAL TAX WITH RESPECT TO ASSESSOR'S PARCELS CREATED AFTER THE LIEN DATE

The special tax formula for CFD No. 1 provides that the Authority will levy the special tax on the taxable parcels in CFD No. 1 at the beginning of each fiscal year, i.e., July 1. The special taxes are included on the County's property tax roll for collection.

The County tax roll includes those assessor's parcels that were in existence as of the general property tax lien date, January 1. An assessor's parcel created between January 1 and July 1, while taxable under the special formula, will not appear on the County tax roll.

The advantage to direct billing for these post-January 1 parcels is that the Authority bills the parcel owner the precise amount of tax for the taxable unit specified in the special tax formula. By adopting Resolution No. 98-6 the Authority will have the option to invoice the special taxes directly to the new parcel owners. This has been done in El Dorado County for other special districts.
